### Summer Camp Rates and Amenities

Effective dates: May 23, 2010 to August 15, 2010

**Campus Day Use Fee: \$10.00.** Each individual attending a conference or event on the Highland Lakes Camp and Conference Center grounds, but is not paying for HLC&CC lodging, or a banquet alone will be responsible to pay a Guest Fee of \$10.00 per day he / she is on the grounds, plus meals.

**Meals: \$6.25 each.** Special menus are available.

### Lodging Rates

*Rates are per individual, per night unless otherwise stated. Meals not included.*

#### Dorms – \$26.50

**maximum of 3 hours per day** for scheduled activities at either the pool or lakefront. Lake activities are subject to weather conditions and water level.

- Outdoor Activities include: Archery Range, Riflery Range, BMX Bikes, Baseball Fields, Basketball Courts, Sand Volleyball Pits, Volleyball Courts, Ping Pong Tables, Frisbee Golf, Recreational Games (Horseshoes, Washers), Hiking Trail, Fishing (bring own equipment & bait)
- Challenge Course: Zip Line and Power Pole only. Maximum per hour Zip Line (30 people) and Power Pole (20 people). Participants must wear closed-toe shoes and be at least 13 years of age and completed the 6<sup>th</sup> grade.

All recreational activities must be submitted to HLC Administration for approved 30-days prior to event.

### Available Options for an Additional Fee:

- Low Ropes is available at the rate of **\$10 per person** and / or High Ropes at the rate of **\$15 per person** (both require 2-4 hours to facilitate). Must be a minimum group size of 24 people and Advance Notice given to enable the scheduling of certified facilitators.
- Rock Climbing Wall – **\$2 per person** (must have completed 6<sup>th</sup> grade)
- Ski Boat to pull 8 or 10-passenger banana water sled is available at the rate of **\$75 per hour / per boat**. Price includes: boat driver, fuel, lifejackets, and lifeguard.

### Reservations

Reservations are confirmed through a signed contract and deposit. A 20% nonrefundable deposit and signed contract must be returned within three weeks of date contract issued. This signed contract commits to pay for 90% of the expected number of guests. Final payment should be made payable upon arrival.
